Overwhelmed by

choice, feedback and constant FOMO

18-34 year olds interviewed

53% thought marriage vows should be renewed

43% would support a "Beta marriage" with a two-year trial period

40% said they believed the "death do us part" should be removed and you can leave without consequences 56% of men and women believe Marriage can be successful whether it lasts forever or not Considerations... from the US Bureau of the Census and Social Security Agency

-38 % of all American workers made less than \$20,000 last year.

-51 % of all American workers made less than \$30,000 last year.

-62 % of all American workers made less than \$40,000 last year.

-71 % of all American workers made less than \$50,000 last year.

The federal poverty level for a family of five is \$28,410, and yet almost 40 percent of all American workers do not even bring in \$20,000 a year.

Forbes reports

56 percent of Americans have less than \$1,000 in their checking and savings accounts combined

Nearly a quarter (24.8 percent) have less than \$100 to their name.

Another deep breath...

25% of Americans have a negative net-worth.

"If you've no debts and have \$10 in your pocket you have more wealth than 25% of Americans."

It has been estimated that it takes approximately \$50,000 a year to support a middle class lifestyle for a family of four in the U.S. today,

71 percent of all workers make less than that amount
